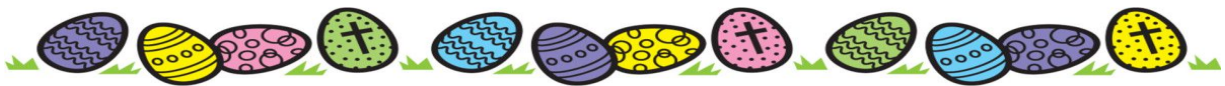
La classe de Madame Fry
