### Social Studies

Students are learning all about maps. We are exploring different types of maps and what types of things are typically found in a map. We recently learned that maps are created from a bird's eye view and include such things as a compass rose, a title, a legend, a scale and symbols. I would encourage the students to create their own maps at home of their neighborhood, their home, their bedroom, or a favorite park. Any students who do so are welcome to share their maps with the class during Social Studies this month.

#### Math

We have now launched our unit on measurement. We have learned about measuring length and about the vocabulary that we use to describe this type of measurement. We will additionally be learning about measuring distance, capacity, weight and surface area. You can continue to keep up to date by checking out our website.

### French

Students recently finished learning about and using Easter themed vocabulary.

We are currently learning about dental health and as such are doing a mini unit on teeth in French. We will be learning and writing about how to take care of our teeth, as well as about the exciting changes that we are noticing in our mouths this year as our teeth get loose and start to fall out. ## English

We are currently learning about non-fiction writing and research. We have talked about the differences between fiction and non-fiction writing, and have talked about how and why we read both genres. Students have additionally learned what it means to research and that they can gather information from a variety of sources. They will soon have the opportunity to choose a research topic. If you have the chance, please talk to your child about what they would like to research and how they plan to find information on the topic.

## Science

We are finishing up our unit on building things and will be done by the end of this week. We will then begin talking about spring as well as the needs to plants and animals as we prepare our garden for a new growing season.
